

Steps to Add WYSIWYG Support to Discussion Template

Copy design elements from the FCKeditor Resources db

1. Copy all the image resources together to the Discussion Template
2. Copy all the forms without modification
3. Copy the (\$CoexEditImages) view without modification
4. Create a view copied from the All Documents view and give it the name (ExamplesForPicking) with the alias ExamplesForPicking. Do not simply copy the view from the resources db. Open the (ExamplesForPicking) view from the resources db and copy the second column, which has the formula to create the doclink symbol. Open the new (ExamplesForPicking) view you created and put your cursor on the Topic column and paste (which will put it just before the Topic column).
5. Copy the two page design elements without modification
6. Copy the two subforms, WebSubform and NotesSubform, without modification
7. Copy the agent SingleWebQuerySave without modification (if you wanted to use a different view than All Documents, you would have to change two references in this agent).

Modifying existing design elements

1. Edit the Main Topic form, and go to where the Body field is currently. Remove the field, and in its place, insert a computed subform with the formula `@ClientType + "Subform"`.
2. Edit the All Documents view and replace the SELECT form `!= "Interest Profile"` with SELECT form `!= "Interest Profile" & & !@Begins(form; "$CoexEdit")`
3. Edit other view to perform similar changes
4. Edit the Main Topic form again to change the onLoad event to `doLoadFCKEditor();`
5. Perform similar changes to Response and Response to Response forms
